

Kodokan Boston Demonstration History

Members of Kodokan Boston have done a variety of demonstrations, demonstration classes, and seminars both around the United States and abroad. Some of the organizations and events we have presented for include:

The Children's Museum; Boston

A series of three 20 minute demos and short classes for the museum's annual Summer Performing Artists series.

Showa Boston

A 45 minute demonstration for the college's bi-annual cultural fair. Showa Boston is a Boston based branch of Showa University, in Japan.

The Japan Society of Boston

A 30 minute demonstration for the 2001 Oshogatsu (New Year's) celebration, done in conjunction with the Children's Museum.

Green Street Studios Center for Movement and Dance; Cambridge

A series of 15 minute demonstrations for the studio's annual fundraising concerts.

University of Massachusetts at Amherst

A series of 15 to 40 minute demonstrations for the University's annual Asian Cultural Fair, yearly from 1980 to 1995.

Boulder Arts Council, Boulder; CO

A 30 minute demonstration for the city of Boulder as part of their winter fair.

Montreal Shorin Ryu Karate; Montreal, Quebec

A 45 minute demonstration and 2 hour seminar for the organization.

Netherlands Meibukan Association; Niemejin, Holland

A 45 minute demonstration and 6 hour seminar for the organization.

Kagoshima Board of Education, Athletic Division; Kagoshima City, Japan

A 1 hour demonstration for the Prefectural Athletics Fair.

Zen Okinawa Kobudo Renmei; Naha, Okinawa, Japan

A 10 minute demonstration as part of the organization's annual demonstration. Members of Kodokan Boston have participated a number of times since 1986.
